RESOLUTION NO. 7413

CITY OF SOUTH GATE  
LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF SOUTH GATE SUPPORTING THE CALIFORNIA  
PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL TO ENCOURAGE  
MANUFACTURERS TO TAKE GREATER  
RESPONSIBILITY FOR PRODUCING ENVIRONMENTALLY  
FRIENDLY PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board recently adopted a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for metal pollutants in urban runoff discharging to the Los Angeles River; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2010, the City of South Gate, along with other affected cities, submitted an Implementation Plan to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board describing how these metal pollutants would be reduced; and

WHEREAS, one of the key components of the Implementation Plan is the reduction of pollutants at the source; and

WHEREAS, certain manufacturer's products are considered the source; and

WHEREAS, The California Product Stewardship Council encourages manufacturers to take responsibility for the content and disposal of their products; and

WHEREAS, many potentially recyclable and reusable products are not readily recyclable; and

WHEREAS, many of these products currently may contain environmentally harmful materials; and

WHEREAS, these potentially recyclable and reusable products may often end up on city streets as trash and litter; and

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of South Gate fully supports efforts by the California Product Stewardship Council to encourage manufacturers to take greater responsibility for the content, disposal and/or recycling of their products.

**SECTION 2.** The City Clerk shall forward a copy of this Resolution to the California Product Stewardship Council.

**SECTION 3.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution which shall become effective upon its adoption.




