

SF Safe Drug Disposal Ordinance – Amendments for 11/23/10

- Page 5 lines 10-11: Update the findings to state that "San Francisco residents requested more than 9,000 mail-back envelopes within the first 18 months of the program."
- page 7, line 16: Clarify that as part of their Product Stewardship Plans, manufacturers are responsible for the costs of public outreach and education, and program evaluation.
- Page 8 line 19 through page 9 line 2: Directs DoE to create a template for the Product Stewardship Plans to guide the manufacturers in submitting their plans. The template shall designate performance categories that the manufacturers will use to measure the success of their plans.
- Modifies the dates of implementation as follows:
