



Solutions to 3 Pesky Disposal Problems

What do old batteries, used gift cards and “sharps” (home-generated syringes) have in common? Answer: all three have short lives, and all three end up in the waste stream somewhere – hopefully not in your home trash can.

Don't Get Stuck

Since 2008, sharps and medical needles may not be thrown into trash barrels. There are several drop-off locations for sharps waste stored in a properly labeled, puncture resistant container. Locations include:

Can I recycle my used gift cards?

Yes, Gift Cards that have been redeemed can be recycled. Check with your retailer, or, better yet, reload the used card and continue to shop! When you're finished, place your old plastic cards in an envelope (no rubber bands, paper clips or paper) and send them to Earthworks c/o Halprin Ind., 25840 Miles Rd., Bedford, OH 44146. Earthworks collects and remanufactures the used cards. Also, you can sell or trade unused Gift Cards on websites like Plastic Jungle or Swapagift.com.
