towers could have been anywhere on the Edison right-of-way.

“I don’t know how they sleep at night; their conscience cannot be clear,” said Hayes’ neighbor Sandra Bibb.

“They certainly have done everything in their power to accomplish their gain at the expense of our community, the health of our community, the value of our community, now and forever.”

City Councilwoman Margaret Finlay said she understands the concerns.

“Keep in mind that these people had the rug pulled out of them, from under their lives and that’s not right,” she said. “There needs to be something done to compensate these home owners.”

The location of the 220-kilovolt tower closest to the Hayes’ property was selected by residents, Odenthal said. They signed a petition which opposed putting that tower further north as the city had requested, she said.

Hayes said he started his petition only after SCE was preparing to drill in a location not previously discussed with residents.

“We had no choice,” he said.

At the request of Hernandez, D-West Covina, SCE officials have agreed to participate in a meeting with the senator to hear the concerns of Duarte residents.

The CPUC also is expected to send a representative to the meeting.
