### Hendricks Pharmacy is now a Battery Take-Back Location

The state of California banned batteries from disposal in landfills in 2006 because batteries waste valuable metals like zinc and cadmium, which are needed to make new products, particularly electronics. The Call2Recycle® program is paying for all disposal costs associated with the battery recycling. This take-back process reduces costs to the public because battery producers pay for the shipping and recycling. Furthermore, recycling is more convenient for consumers because local retailers host collection locations. Residents can bring any household batteries (rechargeable or alkaline that weigh less than 11 lbs.) and cell phones to the take-back locations. This means that old lithium-ion cell phone and camera batteries along with traditional AAA-D batteries can be brought to the same convenient take-back location.
