A previous internship with the Oregon Sea Grant sparked an interest in water pollution prevention to protect sea life. At UC Davis, Yalin partnered with CPSC to complete a practicum project focused on reducing toxic marine pollution through education on proper disposal of marine flares, and promoting the reuse and recycling of solar panels.
