

FREE Expired Marine Flare Collection Events

Dispose of Your Expired or Unwanted Marine Flares Safely & Responsibly!

Single-use marine flares contain hazardous chemicals that pose risks to human health and the environment. Special collection events for unwanted flares are being held across California.

Open ONLY to recreational boaters who live in or berth their boat in the covered participating areas. Proof of residence or slip fee is required. No commercial flares or other hazardous waste will be accepted!
