CPSC is California's leading educator and advocacy expert on product stewardship, extended producer responsibility (EPR), and green design.

## What Does CPSC Do For Our Funders:

- **Provides a toolkit** to better support current and future sustainability & producer responsibility programs
- Engage in our **advocacy activities**, education initiatives, and important regulatory and policy decisions
- Attend exclusive **Policy & Education Advisory Committee (PEAC)** meetings which discusses current legislation & regulations and advises the CPSC Board on policy direction
- Participate in **monthly calls** for Associates (local government only) to share updates on projects, programs, public education, and state/local policy information
- **Collaborate** on projects addressing hard-to-manage products

### Examples of local government cost-savings from stewardship & EPR programs

**Paint:** Saves \$0.09 per capita annually \*

**Sharps:** Saves \$0.03 per capita annually \*

**Solar:** up to \$715 per household annually \*\*

\* Based on reimbursement values from local government invoices.

\*\* Based on recycling costs per CalRecycle funded pilot projects.

I	< 10,000	\$250
II	10,001-25,000	\$625
III	25,001-50,000	\$1,250
IV	50,001-75,000	\$1,875
V	75,001-100,000	\$2,500
VI	100,001-150,000	\$3,750
VII	150,001-200,000	\$5,000
VIII	200,001-250,000	\$6,250
IX	250,001-300,000	\$7,500
X	300,001+	\$.025 per capita
